### Grade 11 Required Summer Reading Analysis

---

**You are required to read three books:**

**one asterisked book from the Summer 2010 Required Reading List Class of 2012 ,  
one other from the Class of 2012 list (with or without an asterisk),  
and one from the complete JBHS 2010 Summer Reading List.**

As you complete your summer reading books, write an analysis of each one.

In paragraph (essay) form, please include:

- (1) a clear, precise, and concise plot summary that demonstrates your comprehension of the book;
- (2) your reflection on literary features of the book, such as character, setting, theme, or symbolism, or writing style;
- (3) your personal evaluation of the book, supported by specific details; and
- (4) comparisons between the book and the other books read for summer reading.

Please notice that (4) is new to the Grade 11 analysis. Think about significant ways that the books compare in characterization, setting, theme, symbolism, and/or writing style.

*Once you have completed the three analyses (one for each book), post all three **AS A GROUP (one document)** to [www.turnitin.com](http://www.turnitin.com) using the directions on the reverse. Your electronic submission of the responses represents your assertion that your work is your original work and conforms to the Joel Barlow High School policy on academic integrity.*
