

Tips for Meeting with College Representatives

Dress Appropriately—remember first impressions are lasting impressions. For example, do not wear inappropriate clothing or clothing that represents other colleges.

Come Prepared—do as much research as you can about the school in advance. Demonstrate some firsthand knowledge about the school.

Questions?—ask pertinent questions regarding academic programs, campus life, application procedures, financial aid, athletics, etc.

Make a Positive Connection—remember, the admissions representative that visits Barlow will often be the person that evaluates your application. Impress them as much as you can.

Demonstrate Interest—let the admissions rep. know that you are genuinely interested in their school and ask if you can follow up with questions later by email.
