2017 Pamela Goodpaster Service Award

Joel Barlow High School's former Athletic Director, Pamela Goodpaster, left an indelible mark on the JBHS community – both in the classroom and in the administrative realm.

Pam has mentored hundreds of teachers and coaches, and implemented committees pertaining to physical education, health and sportsmanship.

Pam's leadership skills have been felt by students and community leaders alike. Student-athletes have benefited from programs such as the Captains' Council, which provides leadership training for captains of JBHS teams. Her interest in emergency medical service led her to teach an intensive EMT training course, which she continues to this day. So far, more than 400 students that have taken the EMT course have gone on to become doctors, nurses, paramedics, EMTs, trainers and physical therapists.

To honor Pam and her legacy of commitment and service, the JBHS Athletic Department has established the Pamela Goodpaster Service Award. This annual award will provide a monetary scholarship to a deserving student who exemplifies qualities such as service to the community, leadership, teamwork, and a desire to be a lifelong learner.

Award Criteria

One scholarship will be awarded annually to the student who best exemplifies:

- Classroom achievement.
- Sportsmanship on the field of play.
- Leadership both in and out of the classroom.
- A demonstrated involvement in community service, inside or outside of the high school environment.
- A demonstrated interest in one of the following fields of study – physical or health education, sports medicine, athletic training, athletics management, physical therapy, or a related endeavor.

A scholarship committee will read all applications and interview three finalists if necessary in determining the award recipient.

Eligibility

Joel Barlow High School Seniors – Graduating in June 2017.



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How to Apply

Only those entries in compliance with these guidelines will be judged. Please submit copies of your Application Form, Essay, Resume and References:

1. Complete an essay (no more than 500 words) that indicates what service means to you and why you are uniquely qualified to receive the Pamela Goodpaster Service Award.
2. Please include two references that support your application with an account of your leadership skills, ethos of service, or some other personal quality that makes you a good candidate for this service award.
